Mini-golf at the Library Fundraiser

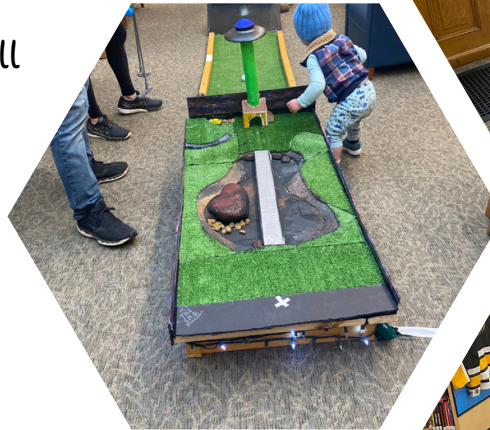
